COLLEGE RECEPTION


The College Reception is your first point of contact at Iona and is open from 8.00am – 4.30pm during the Term and school holidays.

Once your daughter commences, SEQTA Engage will assist you as a parent/guardian to stay informed of your child's grades, upcoming assessments and course information.

WELLBEING CENTRE

The Wellbeing Centre is available to all students for first aid, minor ailments, injury and illness that occurs throughout the school day. If your daughter feels unwell whilst at school, she is to report to College Reception, and she will be directed to the Wellbeing Centre.

The College duty nurse will then decide on a short course of action, which may include contacting a parent/guardian to collect the student if she is deemed too unwell to remain at school.

DEVICE

Students will receive their device at the commencement of Term 1. Further details will be sent closer to the time. Distribution and orientation will involve:


