FEES AND CONDITIONS

Fees are payable each semester, in advance.

The cost for lessons in 2020 will be \$652.50 for 18x thirty-minute lessons in Semester One and \$507.50 for 14x thirty-minute lessons in Semester Two.

Longer lessons can be negotiated with the Music Department and are recommended for advanced students.

The school will issue accounts for music lessons approximately two weeks prior to the commencement of lessons.

Lessons will not be scheduled until payment is received.

It is assumed that students who enrol in private instrumental music lessons will continue these lessons for the length of their time at the College.

One term's notice, in writing, is required to cease music lessons.

The Iona Music School runs a successful Instrumental Music Program, with tuition available for a range of instruments and vocal styles. All students receive tutoring from experienced and professional tutors.

If your daughter is keen to learn an alternative instrument, please contact the Music School and we will endeavour to accommodate her interest. Instrument hire on some instruments is also available from the Music School if required.

It is strongly recommended that students and parents discuss the commencement of a new instrument with the Music School before completing the Enrolment Form. Scholarships and Bursaries are available for some instruments. Scholarship auditions will be held in Term 1 for the commencement of tuition the following year.

MUSIC LESSONS

Lessons are scheduled during school hours on a rotational basis. It is the **student's responsibility** to check her lesson times in advance and attend her lessons on the scheduled day and on time. Timetables will be published on a weekly basis. Non-attendance, without prior notice to the tutor, will result in forfeiture of that lesson.

If the student is sick, the **instrumental tutor** must be notified **directly** by email by 8.00 am on the day of her lesson, otherwise her lesson will not be rescheduled. If a lesson is scheduled during a subject assessment, it is the student's responsibility to inform her instrumental tutor one week before the day of her lesson so her lesson can be rescheduled.

Lessons missed due to absences not authorised by the College e.g. Family holiday, will be forfeited and not be made up.

MUSIC STUDIES DIARY

Music Studies Diaries, which we encourage students to use, are available for purchase from the Music School for \$6. The purpose of the Music Studies Diary is for the tutor to record weekly practice requirements and upcoming lesson times, to communicate with parents and for students to keep a weekly practice record.

PURCHASING MUSIC BOOKS

The photocopying of music is illegal. The AMCOS Copyright Licence held by the College does not allow the copying of print music for purposes of private music teaching. Tutors will inform parents via the Music Diary or email as to which music books are required. Parents are responsible for the purchase of these materials.

MUSIC REPORTS

A Music report will be issued for each student at the end of Semester One and Semester Two. This report will give parents and the student valuable feedback in regards to the student's progress.
